PRODUCT ACTIVITY DATA 852 MAPPING GUIDELINES

These specifications represent the data that Dollar General will be sending to your company to show the movement of your items through our distribution centers and/or stores. All item information will be sent daily **or** weekly at approximately 6am central time with the exception of Sunday which is 4pm central time. Saturday's transmission will not be consistent but should occur if there are no abnormalities. The information is at the item level (selling unit) not case level. If you choose to accept this document, you will see no data for new items until the first order is placed. Existing items should reflect data immediately. **This is not a required document for non-VMI vendors (i.e. vendors receiving 850s).**

If for any reason a DC is missed on a daily transmission, the following day's data will reflect the missed information. The values will be calculated following the guidelines in the detail portion of this document (ZA qualifier information).

If you are receiving this data on a weekly basis, your data will be transmitted on Saturday (collective data from Saturday to Friday) but will not be sent until later in the day (approximately noon).

QO Quantity out of stock (i.e. shipments missed due to lack of inventory). This will be sent for all applicable distribution centers regardless of the quantity (could be zero). ***If you receive this document **weekly**, this figure will be an accumulation of the week's information. *** If a DC fails to upload their inventory information for a **daily** transmission, QO (the following day) will be an accumulation of the missed day's data and the current data. ***

QP Quantity on order (i.e. goods not yet received). This will be sent for all applicable distribution centers regardless of the quantity (could be zero). *** If you receive this document **weekly**, this figure will be a snapshot of Saturday's inventory level.

*** If a DC fails to upload their inventory information for a **daily** transmission, no QP information will be transmitted for that DC. The value in the following day's transmission will reflect the current quantity on order. ***

QR Quantity received. This will be sent for all applicable distribution centers regardless of the quantity (could be zero). *** If you receive this document **weekly**, this figure will be an accumulation of the week's receipts. *** If a DC fails to upload their inventory information for a **daily** transmission, QR (the following day) will be an accumulation of the missed day's data and the current data. ***

QW DC shipment quantity (i.e. amount shipped from a given DC). This will be sent for all applicable distribution centers regardless of the quantity (could be zero). *** If you receive this document **weekly**, this figure will be an accumulation of the week's shipments. *** If a DC fails to upload their inventory information for a **daily** transmission, QW (the following day) will be an accumulation of the missed day's data and the current data. *** **Should QW** increase without explanation via QA (a decrease in QA), please check QD.

QD Automatic shipments (i.e. goods forced to the stores/warehouse allocations). This will be sent for all applicable distribution centers regardless of the quantity (could be zero). *** If you receive this document weekly, this figure will be a snapshot of Saturday's automatic shipments. *** If a DC fails to upload their inventory information for a daily transmission, no QD information will be transmitted for that DC. The value in the following day's transmission will reflect the current automatic shipment quantity. *** QD should be used as a tool for explaining decreases in QA when QW does not increase. And increases in QW when QA does not decrease.

Note: This information was formerly represented by QT.

QT Adjustment to inventory quantity (i.e. adjustments created by inventory cycle counts). This number could be represented as a negative number. This will be sent for all applicable distribution centers regardless of the quantity (could be zero). *** If you receive this document **weekly**, this figure will be an accumulation of the week's adjustments. *** If a DC fails to upload their inventory information for a **daily** transmission, QT (the following day) will be an accumulation of the missed day's data and the current data. ***

QS POS sales quantity (i.e. store sales rolled up to the servicing DC). This will be sent for all applicable distribution centers regardless of the quantity (could be zero). *** If you receive this document **weekly**, this figure will be an accumulation of the week's sales.*** If you're receiving this data daily, it will be week to date . (Sunday 100, Monday 150, Tuesday 160 and so on). ***If data is **missed** on a daily transmission, this value will be an accumulation of the missed day's data and the current data.***

NOTE: POS information is to be used for planning not for replenishment.
